LABRADOR MARINE'S COMMITMENT TO HEALTH AND SAFETY

Labrador Marine continues to monitor the global COVID-19 pandemic. We recognize the uncertainty and anxiety on everyone's part.

We want to assure you that Labrador Marine remains committed to the health and safety of everyone who uses our services. We ask customers and employees to follow the advice provided by the Public Health Agency of Canada, and provincial and federal governments.

As part of our commitment to a safe and healthy travelling environment, Labrador Marine is providing additional cleaning measures on the *Kamutik W*. We have increased the frequency of cleaning for common passenger areas. Passenger cabins are sanitized between crossings. We have also substantially reduced passenger capacity to 120.

We have posted public health advice throughout the ship. Customers are encouraged to practice social distancing techniques and to make all efforts to keep approximately 6 feet away from other passengers. This is a proven and effective way of reducing the transmission of germs.

Other important public health tips to stay safe onboard:

- Wash your hands frequently with soap and water for 20 seconds.
- Avoid touching your hands, nose, or mouth.
- Cough or sneeze into the bend of your arm or into a tissue. Discard the tissue after use.
